

- c. Read from an **unmarked Bible**. This allows you to approach the Word with an open slate, and not immediately think about familiar verses.
- d. Beginners start by reading 2-3 verses a day in the New
 Testament and continue until you have read the entire New
 Testament. Then you can begin, at any time, a program to read through the Bible.
- e. Don't worry if you miss a day. The key is to build a discipline that does not get derailed if you miss a day. The goal is not to finish the Bible in a year, the goal is to encounter the Lord and experience His life changing presence!
