Following Jesus will make you a better person.

Look in your heart for sins that hurt your conscience.

Put to death anything that belongs to your earthly nature. Get rid of your sexual sins and unclean acts. Don't let your feelings get out of control. Remove from your life all evil longings. Stop always wanting more and more. You might as well be worshiping statues of gods. God's anger is going to come because of those things.

Show that you want to follow Jesus by taking Communion.

When he had given thanks, he broke bread. He said, "This is my body. It is given for you. Every time you eat it, do it in memory of me." In the same way, after supper he took the cup. He said, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Every time you drink it, do it in memory of me." When you eat the bread and drink the cup, you are announcing the Lord's death until he comes again. 1 Corinthians 11:24-26



Ask God for the Holy Spirit to have more of God's power.

Don't fill yourself up with wine. Getting drunk will lead to wild living. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit. Speak to each other with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord.


Support your church by giving tithes.


1 Thessalonians 4:16-17
